Please let this letter serve as recommendation for an outstanding company, MonuMedic, Inc.

**Fate:** MonuMedic, Inc. walked into my office. We went to the site where the Shea-Magrath Monument is located. They told me that **YES!!!!!** They could restore the plaques without replacing them. They promptly evaluatated them, sent me an estimate, came and reviewed all possibilities and presented a fair and reasonable price.

Time Line: Our Shea-Magrath Ceremony each year is held on the Sunday one week prior to Memorial Day. MonuMedic, Inc. worked diligently to have them in place for the Ceremony. We had hundreds of veterans, families and businesses, who donated funds and attended the Ceremony. The three plaques were like new placed on the monument that was repaired, cleaned with a new plaque honoring two recent soldiers.
